

# Country Liaison Officer

## Who is my CLO?

1. The Country Liaison Officer, or “CLO”, is an officer from your country that supervises and administers you as an International Military Student.
  - The CLO will explain your customs and special requirements to training installation personnel, and assist you in familiarization with the installation and training, while monitoring your adherence to regulations and security requirements.
2. He is the officer from your host nation responsible for discipline and decisions that require disposition of students from your country.
3. In most cases, your CLO will be located in Washington, DC.

## Military Meals

### Military Facilities

1. If you are going to use military dining facilities, it is acceptable to request meals that comply with dietary prohibitions. However, you must use the dining facility if available to you.
2. No increase in living allowance will occur under the IMET program, nor will a certificate of non-availability be issued for dietary restrictions alone, based solely on refusal to use military dining facilities offered.

### Civilian Facilities

1. You should be aware that US dining facilities serve all military personnel, regardless of rank or status.
2. All patrons wait in line, are served and seated on a first come, first served basis.

## Off-Duty (Civilian) Employment

### Can I have an Additional Job While in the U.S?

1. While in the United States on an A2, NATO-2 or NATO-6 visa, neither you nor your dependents may accept any employment.
